Matthew 3:7

But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to his baptism, he said to them, “Brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?”

Matthew 5:20

For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 9:11

And when the Pharisees saw it, they said to His disciples, “Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?”

Matthew 9:14

[Jesus Is Questioned About Fasting] Then the disciples of John came to Him, saying, “Why do we and the Pharisees fast often, but Your disciples do not fast?”

Matthew 9:34

But the Pharisees said, “He casts out demons by the ruler of the demons.”

Matthew 12:2

And when the Pharisees saw it, they said to Him, “Look, Your disciples are doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath!”

Matthew 12:14

Then the Pharisees went out and plotted against Him, how they might destroy Him.

Matthew 12:24

Now when the Pharisees heard it they said, “This fellow does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons.”

Matthew 12:38

[The Scribes and Pharisees Ask for a Sign] Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered, saying, “Teacher, we want to see a sign from You.”

Matthew 15:1

[Defilement Comes from Within] Then the scribes and Pharisees who were from Jerusalem came to Jesus, saying,

Matthew 15:12

Then His disciples came and said to Him, “Do You know that the Pharisees were offended when they heard this saying?”

Matthew 16:1

[The Pharisees and Sadducees Seek a Sign] Then the Pharisees and Sadducees came, and testing Him asked that He would show them a sign from heaven.

Matthew 16:5

[The Leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees] Now when His disciples had come to the other side, they had forgotten to take bread.

Matthew 16:6

Then Jesus said to them, “Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.”

Matthew 16:11

How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread?—but to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees.”

Matthew 16:12

Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Matthew 19:3

The Pharisees also came to Him, testing Him, and saying to Him, “Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for just any reason?”

Matthew 21:45

Now when the chief priests and Pharisees heard His parables, they perceived that He was speaking of them.

Matthew 22:15

[The Pharisees: Is It Lawful to Pay Taxes to Caesar?] Then the Pharisees went and plotted how they might entangle Him in His talk.

Matthew 22:34

[The Scribes: Which Is the First Commandment of All?] But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together.

Matthew 22:41

[Jesus: How Can David Call His Descendant Lord?] While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them,

Matthew 23:1-2

[Woe to the Scribes and Pharisees] Then Jesus spoke to the multitudes and to His disciples, saying: “The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses’ seat.

Matthew 23:13

“But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in.

Matthew 23:14

Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long prayers. Therefore you will receive greater condemnation.

Matthew 23:15

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel land and sea to win one proselyte, and when he is won, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

Matthew 23:23

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.

Matthew 23:25

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you cleanse the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of extortion and self-indulgence.

Matthew 23:27

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

Matthew 23:29

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because you build the tombs of the prophets and adorn the monuments of the righteous,

Matthew 27:62

[Pilate Sets a Guard] On the next day, which followed the Day of Preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees gathered together to Pilate,

Mark 2:16

And when the scribes and Pharisees saw Him eating with the tax collectors and sinners, they said to His disciples, “How is it that He eats and drinks with tax collectors and sinners?”

Mark 2:18

[Jesus Is Questioned About Fasting] The disciples of John and of the Pharisees were fasting. Then they came and said to Him, “Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but Your disciples do not fast?”

Mark 2:24

And the Pharisees said to Him, “Look, why do they do what is not lawful on the Sabbath?”

Mark 3:6

Then the Pharisees went out and immediately plotted with the Herodians against Him, how they might destroy Him.

Mark 7:1

[Defilement Comes from Within] Then the Pharisees and some of the scribes came together to Him, having come from Jerusalem.

Mark 7:3

For the Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they wash their hands in a special way, holding the tradition of the elders.

Mark 7:5

Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?"

Mark 8:11

[The Pharisees Seek a Sign] Then the Pharisees came out and began to dispute with Him, seeking from Him a sign from heaven, testing Him.

Mark 8:13

[Beware of the Leaven of the Pharisees and Herod] And He left them, and getting into the boat again, departed to the other side.

Mark 8:15

Then He charged them, saying, "Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod."

Mark 10:2

The Pharisees came and asked Him, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?" testing Him.

Mark 12:13

[The Pharisees: Is It Lawful to Pay Taxes to Caesar?] Then they sent to Him some of the Pharisees and the Herodians, to catch Him in His words.

Luke 5:17

[Jesus Forgives and Heals a Paralytic] Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

Luke 5:21

And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, "Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

Luke 5:30

And their scribes and the Pharisees complained against His disciples, saying, “Why do You eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?”

Luke 5:33

[Jesus Is Questioned About Fasting] Then they said to Him, “Why do the disciples of John fast often and make prayers, and likewise those of the Pharisees, but Yours eat and drink?”

Luke 6:2

And some of the Pharisees said to them, “Why are you doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath?”

Luke 6:7

So the scribes and Pharisees watched Him closely, whether He would heal on the Sabbath, that they might find an accusation against Him.

Luke 7:30

But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the will of God for themselves, not having been baptized by him.

Luke 7:36

[A Sinful Woman Forgiven] Then one of the Pharisees asked Him to eat with him. And He went to the Pharisee’s house, and sat down to eat.

Luke 11:37

[Woe to the Pharisees and Lawyers] And as He spoke, a certain Pharisee asked Him to dine with him. So He went in and sat down to eat.

Luke 11:39

Then the Lord said to him, “Now you Pharisees make the outside of the cup and dish clean, but your inward part is full of greed and wickedness.

Luke 11:42

“But woe to you Pharisees! For you tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass by justice and the love of God. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.

Luke 11:43

Woe to you Pharisees! For you love the best seats in the synagogues and greetings in the marketplaces.

Luke 11:44

Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like graves which are not seen, and the men who walk over them are not aware of them.”

Luke 11:53

And as He said these things to them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to assail Him vehemently, and to cross-examine Him about many things,

Luke 12:1

[Beware of Hypocrisy] In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first of all, "Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

Luke 13:31

On that very day some Pharisees came, saying to Him, "Get out and depart from here, for Herod wants to kill You."

Luke 14:1

[A Man with Dropsy Healed on the Sabbath] Now it happened, as He went into the house of one of the rulers of the Pharisees to eat bread on the Sabbath, that they watched Him closely.

Luke 14:3

And Jesus, answering, spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?"

Luke 15:2

And the Pharisees and scribes complained, saying, "This Man receives sinners and eats with them."

Luke 16:14

[The Law, the Prophets, and the Kingdom] Now the Pharisees, who were lovers of money, also heard all these things, and they derided Him.

Luke 17:20

[The Coming of the Kingdom] Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation;

Luke 19:39

And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."

Luke 20:20

[The Pharisees: Is It Lawful to Pay Taxes to Caesar?] So they watched Him, and sent spies who pretended to be righteous, that they might seize on His words, in order to deliver Him to the power and the authority of the governor.

John 1:24

Now those who were sent were from the Pharisees.

John 3:1

[The New Birth] There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews.

John 4:1

[A Samaritan Woman Meets Her Messiah] Therefore, when the Lord knew that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John

John 7:32

[Jesus and the Religious Leaders] The Pharisees heard the crowd murmuring these things concerning Him, and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take Him.

John 7:45

[Rejected by the Authorities] Then the officers came to the chief priests and Pharisees, who said to them, "Why have you not brought Him?"

John 7:47

Then the Pharisees answered them, "Are you also deceived?"

John 7:48

Have any of the rulers or the Pharisees believed in Him?

John 8:3

Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst,

John 8:13

[Jesus Defends His Self-Witness] The Pharisees therefore said to Him, "You bear witness of Yourself; Your witness is not true."

John 9:13

[The Pharisees Excommunicate the Healed Man] They brought him who formerly was blind to the Pharisees.

John 9:15

Then the Pharisees also asked him again how he had received his sight. He said to them, "He put clay on my eyes, and I washed, and I see."

John 9:16

Therefore some of the Pharisees said, "This Man is not from God, because He does not keep the Sabbath." Others said, "How can a man who is a sinner do such signs?" And there was a division among them.

John 9:40

Then some of the Pharisees who were with Him heard these words, and said to Him, "Are we blind also?"

John 11:46

But some of them went away to the Pharisees and told them the things Jesus did.

John 11:47

Then the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered a council and said, "What shall we do? For this Man works many signs.

John 11:57

Now both the chief priests and the Pharisees had given a command, that if anyone knew where He was, he should report it, that they might seize Him.

John 12:19

The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, "You see that you are accomplishing nothing. Look, the world has gone after Him!"

John 12:42

[Walk in the Light] Nevertheless even among the rulers many believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they did not confess Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue;

John 18:3

Then Judas, having received a detachment of troops, and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, came there with lanterns, torches, and weapons.

Acts 15:5

But some of the sect of the Pharisees who believed rose up, saying, "It is necessary to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses."
